Leeward Islands, Netherlands (Saba, St. Eustatius, St. Maarten)					
Netherlands Antilles (Curacao, Bonaire)					
Saba (pronounced "SAY-ba") is the smallest island of the Netherlands Antilles					
Sint Eustatius (also Saint Eustace and Statia) is one of the islands making up the Netherlands Antilles					
The southern Dutch half is called Sint Maarten and is part of the Netherlands Antilles; the northern French half is called Saint-Martin and is part of the French overseas région and département of Guadeloupe					
Bonaire is an island in the Netherlands Antilles					
Curaçao (pronounced [kura'são]) is an island in the southern part of the Caribbean Sea off the coast of Venezuela. The isle is the largest and most populous of the three so-called ABC (for Aruba, Bonaire, and Curaçao) and belongs to the Netherlands Antilles,
